Situated in the heart of Romania, Brasov is, and has been, an important city for centuries.

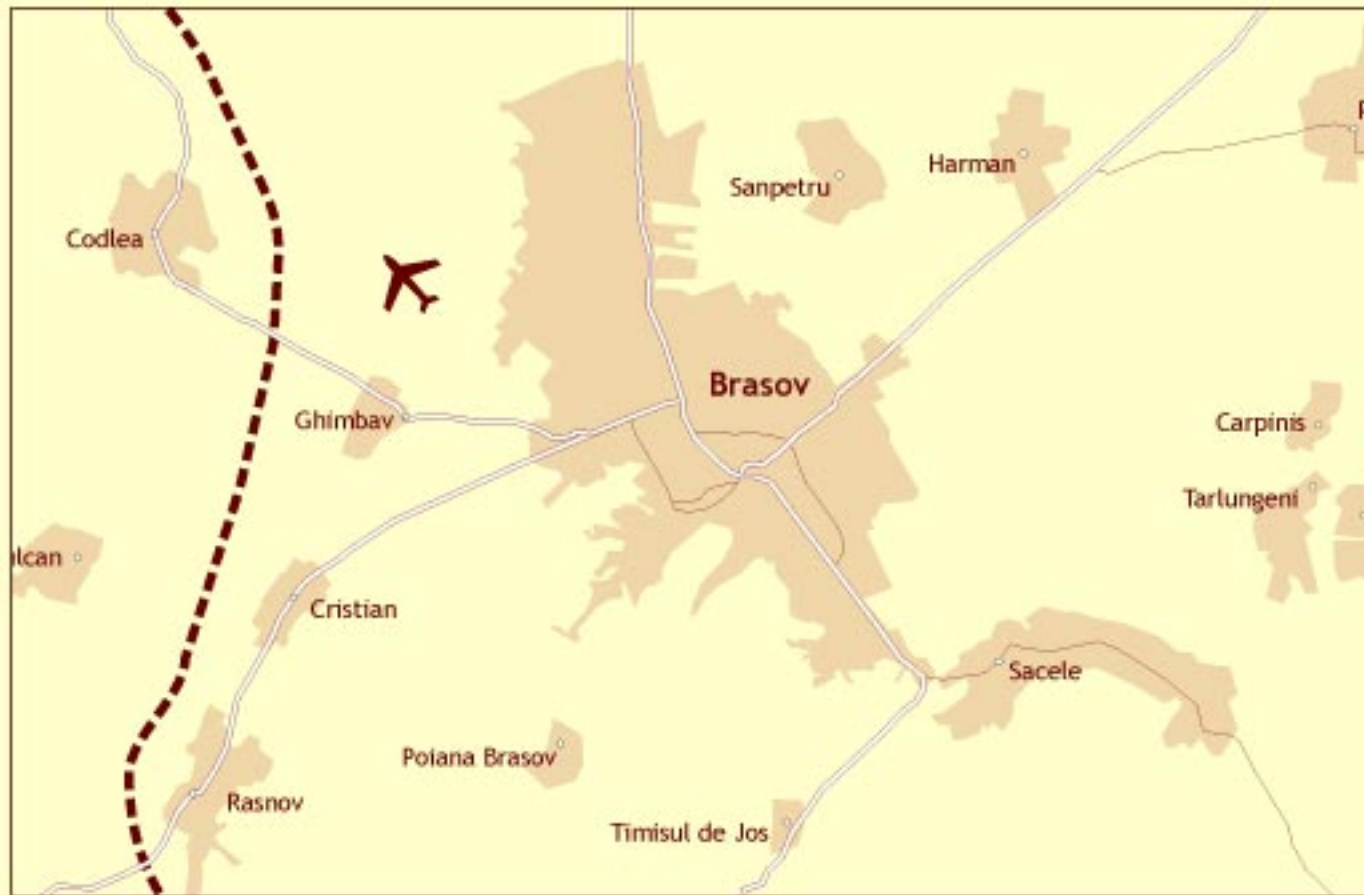
It has been attracting considerable foreign investment for many years before Romania's admission to the EU and many international companies have set up offices in the city.

Poiana Brasov

Poiana Brasov, the glade of Brasov, is situated on a plateau at the foot of Postavarul Mountain which is part of the Meridional Carpathian Range.

It is located only 7.5 miles (12Km) from the Mediaeval part of Brasov and is at an altitude of over 3346 ft (1020 m).

Poiana Brasov provides a peaceful oasis for all kinds of tourists at all times of the year.



Poiana Brasov is a modern ski resort with luxurious hotels, mid range villas and mansions, excellent restaurants, bars and clubs that attract guests from around the world as well as all over Romania. Bran

Bran Castle, probably better known as Dracula's Castle is a short drive of 18.6 miles (30 km) from Brasov.

The castle set high on it's rocky mound is of historic and architectural interest but is also an important tourist attraction for the area because of the fascination with it's connection to the Dracula myths of Bram Stoker's novel.

Thanks to the popularity of the castle, the village of Bran has developed, luckily on good traditional lines, to accommodate an ever increasing number of tourists. Many attractive villas have been built and the stalls of the craft market offer many examples of local traditional handicrafts.

Predeal

Predeal, the northernmost resort on the Prahova Valley, 15.5 miles (25 km) from Brasov, 9.9 miles (16 km) from Sinaia, 91 miles (147 km) from Bucharest, is the town on the highest elevation in Romania at 3389 ft (1033m) altitude.



It is surrounded by five massifs: Postavaru, Piatra Mare, Bucegi, Baiului and Fitifoi, being a good base for mountain hikes and, in winter, for skiing down the Clabucet and Cioplea slopes. The name is derived from Romanian "predeal" which means "on the hill".

Rasnov

Rasnov is located in the Tara Barsei basin, surrounded by the outstandingly beautiful mountains of Bucegi, Piatra Craiului and Postavaru all offering walking and climbing trips of wide ranging difficulties.

It would be a great pity for travelers to Bran or Brasov, not to pay a short visit to Rasnov. A tour of the ancient fortress, or citadel, perched high above the town and a little refreshment will give a chance to see a truly beautiful and spectacular view of Tara Barsei, while the museum in the fortress takes the visitor on a snapshot trip back in time.
